## FRIST FRIDAY Frequently Asked Questions

### GETTING HERE

Where should I park?

Frist Art Museum parking is limited. For Frist Friday, the flat rate is \$6 per car, but our lots often fill up before the event begins.

Taxis and ride shares are highly encouraged.

The following options are nearby. The rates at these lots are determined by their operators, and the Frist Art Museum does not validate or offer discounts on parking in these lots.

Is there a ride share discount code for Frist Friday?

What time should I arrive?

The event is from 6 to 9 p.m. The galleries and Martin ArtQuest open at 10 a.m., and check in for Frist Friday begins at 4 p.m. (Frist Friday pricing will also begin at 4 p.m.) We encourage you to arrive early if you want to partake of the exhibition-themed food and beverage tastings, as supplies are limited.

### TICKETS

Why should I prepurchase tickets?

Space is limited, and we expect to sell out, so if you are not yet a Frist Art Museum member, be sure to buy your ticket as soon as you can.

How much are tickets?

\$20 for non-members and \$15 for college students. Members get in free.

I'm a member. Do I need to purchase a ticket?

No. Just show your member and photo IDs at check-in.

I'm a member. Can I bring a guest?

Member guest passes are not accepted at Frist Fridays. Not-yet-member guests will need to purchase Frist Friday tickets.

## CHECK-IN

Where is check-in?

Check-in will be on the Demonbreun side of the building, in our café.

What do I need for check-in?

If you're a non-member, please have your ticket ready to scan. It can be printed out or on a mobile device. We'll need to see your photo ID, too.

If you're a member, have your member card and photo ID ready.

If you're a college student, have your school ID ready as well.

Can I bring a bag?

Yes. For the safety of our guests, all bags and containers (including purses) will be inspected upon entry. We advise leaving backpacks and other large items at home, as they're not allowed in the galleries.

## PROGRAMMING

What's the schedule of events?

We'll publish the schedule of events online as soon as possible, and printed copies will be available at check-in.

Will all the galleries be open?

Yes. Don't miss [A Sporting Vision](#); [Van Gogh, Monet, Degas, and Their Times](#); [Claudio Parmiggiani](#); [Dorothea Lange](#); and [Connect/Disconnect](#).

What does the ticket cover?

You'll receive admission to the galleries (including talks and tours), activities and live performances in the auditorium. You'll also have access to a food tasting sponsored by Von Elrod's and a beverage tasting sponsored by Tailgate Brewery (while supplies last).

## FOOD AND BEVERAGE

What time do the bars close?

8:30 p.m.

What are the food options?

Bob's Fish Fry, Daddy's Dogs, Il Forno Pizzeria, and S'more Love Bakery will sell food in the courtyard.

Will the café be open?

The café will be the site of check-in, so it will not serve food or beverages during Frist Friday.

Where can I buy a bottle of water?

Bottled water can be purchased at any of the bars in the lobby. The food trucks and carts in the courtyard will also sell non-alcoholic beverages.

## MISCELLANEOUS

My employer is a corporate sponsor. Do I get free admission?

No (unless Frist Friday admission is specifically noted in your employer's sponsorship agreement). Please buy your ticket in advance!

What's the rain plan?

Frist Friday is now indoors, so a rain plan is no longer necessary! The food trucks and carts in the courtyard will operate rain or shine.

It is possible that you'll have to wait outside of the café for a few minutes before checking in, so dress accordingly.

Where is coat check?

You can leave your coat in the Rechter Room, which is located just past the bag inspection station, on the left side of the entryway. The coat-check is self-serve, and the Frist Art Museum is not responsible for your belongings.

Can I buy tickets for other people?

Absolutely! Be sure to get them online, in advance.

What is the suggested attire?

Casual wear is appropriate at the Frist most of the time, including Frist Friday. If you want to celebrate *A Sporting Vision* or *Van Gogh, Monet, Degas, and Their Times* by dressing up in period clothing or a festive outfit, we look forward to admiring your attire.

Can I bring my kids?

Of course! The event is family friendly, and kids 18 and younger always receive free admission to the Frist, including on Frist Fridays.
