Alcohol is sold "by the drink" based on consumption expense. Specialty drink prices are based on their mixed components. A \$500.00 per bar sales minimum applies. Additional charges apply for service labor and equipment rentals. Glassware rental is required when events are in multiple spaces, the bar exceeds 3.5 hours, and the guest count is 200 and above. Glassware for a Limited Host Bar is provided by the Frist for a 200-guest/2-hour service maximum. Special alcohol requests require advance notice and are provided based on availability. Donated alcohol is not permitted.

Event host must comply with all alcoholic beverage statutes of the State of Tennessee. Alcoholic beverages are not to be brought into or taken from the Frist Art Museum. The museum reserves the right to check for proper identification for legal drinking age verification and to refuse alcohol beverage service to any individual at any time.

A customary 20% service charge and applicable sales tax will apply to the total consumption, labor, and rentals.
