

Illuminated Letter

Let's make an illuminated letter!

Illuminated manuscripts are precious books that are written and illustrated by hand. *Illuminated* means "shiny," and artists sometimes used real gold and silver to decorate the pages and make the patterns shiny and bright. Let's use foil to create a special page of our own.

Materials

Pencil Ruler Cardboard Scissors Foil Glue

Use a pencil and a ruler to measure a rectangle that is 7 inches tall and 5 inches wide on a piece of cardboard. Cut out the rectangle.



Carefully cut out the foil letter, and glue it to the middle of your cardboard rectangle.



Cut out some designs in the foil and glue them onto your page to decorate it.



Roll out a piece of foil. Using your pencil, lightly outline the first letter of your name as a block letter.

Make sure not to press down too hard!



Add a border by cutting out smaller foil shapes and gluing them around the edges of the rectangle.



Gently use your pencil to make patterns in the foil on the page.
