


Desert Silhouette Sunset

Materials

Two 8 1/2 x 11 in. sheets of heavy paper (one black, one white)


Crayons Pencil Scissors Glue




Think of a sunset. Color the center of the white sheet yellow. Add orange and red layers around it. Then fill the rest of the page with sky colors like blue or gray.



Cut off the bottom third of the black paper and set it aside. On the rest of the sheet, draw some shapes of plants or animals you might see in a desert.



Cut the shapes out of the black paper.



Take the strip of black paper you set aside. Glue it to the bottom third of your sunset sheet. Arrange your desert shapes along the top edge of the black strip, and glue them into place.
