

# Frist Art Museum

## 2022 Photography and Videography Guidelines

A Frist Art Museum representative must be present during photography or videography shoots. Sessions must not interrupt the daily operations of the facility or impede visitor entry into and exit from various areas of the museum. Unscheduled sessions will not be accommodated, and their participants denied access to museum areas. Guidelines are subject to change based on the exhibit

### Open areas

Private event photography with flash is allowed in the Grand Lobby (restrictions may apply), Rechter Room, auditorium, and outdoor spaces.

### Galleries

Photography for noncommercial, personal cell use may be permitted in the exhibition galleries during special events. If a client wishes to have photography in the Conte Community Arts Gallery, the Contemporary Artists Project Gallery, the Ingram Gallery, and/or the Upper-Level Galleries, a separate agreement must be made in advance. Permission will be granted on a case-by-case basis, and additional restrictions may apply because of contractual obligations to lenders and rightsholders for the exhibitions on view.

### Bridal and wedding

A \$350.00 per hour fee (a 2-hour maximum during museum operating hours) will be charged for all wedding photo sessions.

### Media

Media photography and videography sessions are to be scheduled and approved by the museum's Communications staff.
