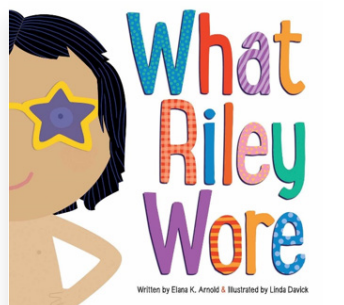

### Family Reading Recommendations



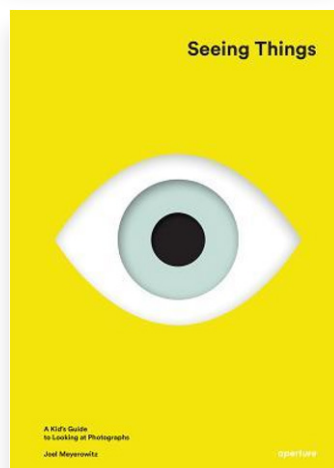
#### **What Riley Wore by Elana K. Arnold (author) and Linda Davick (illustrator)**

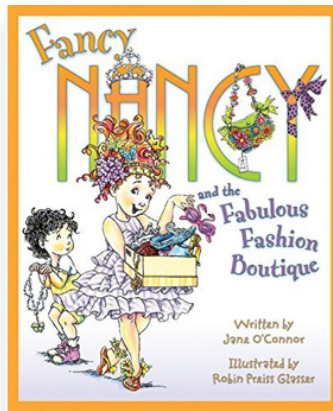
#### **Where Did My Clothes Come From? by Chris Butterworth (author) and Lucia Gaggiotti (illustrator)**

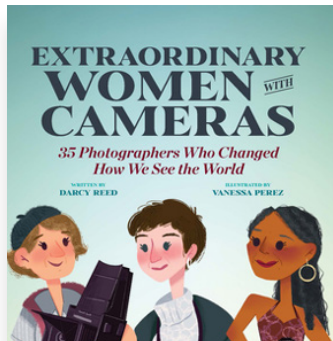
#### **Seeing Things: A Kid's Guide to Looking at Photographs by Joel Meyerowitz (author and photographer)**

Aimed at children ages 8–12, *Seeing Things* is a wonderful introduction to photography that asks how photographers transform ordinary things into meaningful moments. Beloved photographer Joel Meyerowitz takes readers on a journey through the power and magic of photography—its ability to freeze time, tell a story, and record life's fleeting and beautiful moments. Each picture is accompanied by a short commentary, encouraging readers to look closely and use their imagination to understand key ideas in photography such as light, gesture, composition, and, ultimately, how there is wonder all around us when viewed through the lens.



## ***Fancy Nancy and the Fabulous Fashion Boutique* by Jane O'Connor (author) and Robert Preiss Glasser (illustrator)**

Welcome to Fancy Nancy's Fabulous Fashion Boutique! Here you can find the fanciest almost-new outfits, accessories, jewelry, and lots more. It's Nancy's little sister's birthday, and when it starts to rain, her birthday party might be ruined. Nancy knows she has to come up with an idea—and fast. In this *tres chic* story, Nancy shows once again that sometimes all you need is a little improvising to turn a fiasco into something fancy.



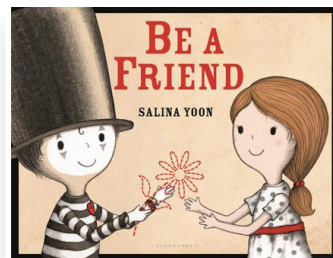
